## Our Children's Program

Developed from the same fine art basics used in our renowned adult program, our children's art classes get results! Our step-by-step program provides each child with the knowledge and skills they need to unleash his or her creativity and the ability to produce beautiful works of art.

Instructors work one-on-one to help each child gain a solid foundation in fine art. With an average of only 6 students per instructor they are assured individual attention.

As young as 5, children begin to acquire fine art skills in drawing and painting from the very first day. With charcoal and pastels they learn to build a drawing using simple shapes to create colorful, 3-dimensional effects making their finished work look more life-like.

Next they enter the fascinating world of watercolor. Each child learns about watercolor materials and how to handle them to create remarkable paintings. They become comfortable with complex techniques and learn



to mix a wide array of colors. The results can only be described as "incredible".

Learning to paint in oils is their next adventure. Following specifically designed painting drills they build greater understanding and artistic skill. They learn oil painting techniques used by the great masters like Monet, Manet, Cezanne, Rembrandt and more. Armed with this knowledge they are prepared to create their own original paintings.

Watching the beaming faces of a child and their parents when their latest completed piece is shared is one of the great pleasures of instructing at Mission: Renaissance.

# Our Founder: Larry Gluck



Born April 9, 1931 in New York, Larry studied as a teen with fine portrait artist, Giuseppe Trotta, a schoolmate of Picasso.


From 1961 to 1971, Larry lived and painted in the U.S. Virgin Islands where he gained

international recognition for his watercolors of this tropical paradise.

In 1971 he and his wife, Sheila and their two children left the Virgin Islands and settled in Los Angeles, where he was soon to experience a life-changing lesson.

So many friends and acquaintances had asked to study with him that Sheila finally persuaded him to teach. To his amazement, he realized that no method of instruction existed to give students a thorough fine art foundation – the kind given to Rembrandt, Michelangelo and even Picasso.

And so, in 1975, Larry and Sheila started the first Mission: Renaissance, an art school with the goal of reinstating the traditional basic skills of fine art no longer being taught. He developed the first complete fine art program uncovering and codifying every step required for a beginner to travel a straight path to artistic excellence - The Gluck Method.

The name was inspired by the then popular 1960's television series, Mission: Impossible with Larry and Sheila's mission the creation of a Renaissance in fine art education. And while seemingly impossible, it is truly being achieved today.
